Dear colleagues, dear friends,

Thanks to the organization of the Hungarian host József Hajdú and Attila Kun the 4<sup>rd</sup> Seminar for young researchers on Labour and Social Law will take place at Szeged University from May 12 to May 15 2011. We have the pleasure to send you the call for participation and the call for abstracts to this seminar which is born in the context of the Network on European Labour and Social Law of Young Researchers.

The network is a platform promoting scientific discussion and cooperation between PhD-students and Post-Docs working in field of European Labour and Social Law. It is supported by senior experts and professors. One of the network's key priorities is to promote European partnerships.

This year we are looking for projects of young researchers that concern:

International Labour Law,  
European Employment, Labour and Social Law  
Comparative Labour Law

Proposals for presentations regarding one of these main research topics are welcome.

We are especially interested in papers that deal with the transformation and changes of the labour market in the 21<sup>st</sup> century with regard to research projects conducted by the Department of Labour Law and Social Security of the University of Szeged and the interdisciplinary research group (SFB) at the law school of the Martin-Luther-University. Topics and especially emphasised issues include European Social Security Coordination, legal aspects of Green Jobs, Youth Employment and collective agreements regulating the access to the labour market.

The presentations shall not be longer than 30 minutes and will be followed by a discussion with other participants and senior researchers. The papers will be written and presented in English. Persons interested in giving a presentation are kindly asked to submit an abstract of the subject they would like to present **within March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2011** via e-mail to Attila Kun (kunattila@freemail.hu), Petra Eszter Deli (deli.petra@juris.u-szeged.hu) and as a copy to Wolfhard Kohte ([kohte@jura.uni-halle.de](mailto:kohte@jura.uni-halle.de)). Participants are free to submit a finished paper, but they are not obliged to do so. In the case you plan to use a handout or a power-point-presentation we beg you to send it **within April, 28<sup>th</sup>, 2011**.
